Qualifications: Horses participating in HTs in 2020 must have hunted at least 5 times during the 2019/20 hunt season. Horses competing in HTs held during 2021 must have hunted at least 5 times during the 2020/21 hunt season. (Master's signature required on entry blank or by email for qualified classes 6 and 13.)

**Special Pandemic Guidelines &
Information**

- **Do NOT attend if:**
 - You don't feel well;
 - You have tested positive for COVID-19 or are showing symptoms; or
 - Have been around someone with symptoms within the past 14 days.

Schooling on Friday, November 6
After 2:00 P.M. or Sunday, November 8
Before 8:30 A.M.

Start Time: 9:00 A.M.

1. **JUNIOR HUNTERS** -To be ridden by a Junior 18 years of age and under for the Elizabeth A Belser Memorial Trophy. Emphasis placed on suitability as a junior hunter. Fences 2'3".
2. **AMATEUR-OWNER HUNTER** -To be ridden by an Amateur Owner over 18 years for the Richard W. Lloyd Memorial Trophy. Emphasis placed on suitability as amateur field hunter. Fences 2'3".
3. **GREEN HUNTERS** -Open to all first-year foxhunters that have not previously shown at these trials or at a recognized horse show. Winner receives the Paulette W. Boykin Memorial Trophy. Fences 2'3".
4. **LOW OPEN HUNTERS** -Open to all entries. Entries Not Eligible for Class 5. Winner receives the Bess & Bob Coughlin Trophy, Fences 2'3".
5. **OPEN HUNTERS** -Open to all entries. Entries Not Eligible for Class 4. Winner receives the David L. Young Memorial Trophy. Fences 3'.
6. **CAROLINAS' FOXHUNTER SERIES:**
CAROLINAS' HILLTOPPER HUNTER -Riders to follow Field Master at a walk, trot, canter, walking over a log and/or open gate. Horses not eligible for any other Class except 7, 8 & 9. Judged on suitability as a hilltopper mount. Martingales allowed.
7. **HUNTER HACK** -To be shown at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop May be asked to trot two fences not to exceed 18". Judged on manners, way of going and suitability as a fox hunting mount. Martingales allowed.
8. **HILLTOPPER HUNTER O/F** -Ridden over a hilltopper course not to exceed 18". Emphasis on suitability as a hilltopper hunter. Entries not eligible for any other Class except 6, 7 & 9. Martingales allowed.

All Class Fees are \$15.00 except Class 15; there is no entry fee for Class 15

- LUNCH BREAK -

9. **HUNT PAIRS UNDER SADDLE** -Open to all entries. To be ridden two abreast at a walk, trot and canter. Judged on pace, performance and general appearance. Martingales allowed.
10. **HUNT PAIRS** -Open to all entries. Ridden two abreast over a designed course for the Howard H. Lamar Jr. Memorial Trophy. Judged on performance, pace and general appearance May jump high or low fences.
11. **HUNT TEAMS** -Open to all entries for the Martha T. Partridge Perpetual Trophy. Judged on Performance, consistency of spacing, pace and general appearance. May jump high or low fences.
12. **HANDY HUNTERS** -Open to all entries with emphasis on manners and promptness. Winner receives the Hilda A. McMahan Trophy. Fences 3'.
13. **CAROLINAS' FOXHUNTER SERIES: CAROLINAS' PERFORMANCE HUNTER** -Open to qualified hunters for the Harry D. Kirkover Perpetual Trophy. Fences 3'.
14. **FIELD HUNTER CHALLENGE** -Ridden over a course not to exceed 3'6" with emphasis on brilliance and style. Winner receives the Robert E. Kiehl Memorial Trophy.
15. **BEST HUNTER AND BEST TURNED OUT** -Open to all entries that have shown in at least one class. To be ridden by a subscriber (Junior or Senior) of any hunt. To follow Field Master and judged as most suitable to ride to hounds. 2nd flight to follow. The Marth H. Williams Perpetual Trophy will be presented to the winner. No entry fees.

Attendees wishing to hunt on Saturday morning may cap.

General Conditions & Information

1. Current 12 month negative Coggins required.
2. All vans & trailers park at the base of Hunter Trial Hill or entrance of Springdale Race Course. Water is NOT available on grounds.
3. Entries taken on schooling day or emailed to therealcamdenhunt@gmail.com.
4. The committee has the right to combine, cancel or split any class.
5. Hunt members are requested to ride in their colors. Jackets required. Braiding is appreciated.
6. Two entries will go in tandem except Classes 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 15.
7. Disputes will be decided by the judges, governed by hunting field experience and conditions, and by show ring procedure and etiquette where applicable and not conflicting with these conditions.
8. No claim for damages that may happen to onlookers, exhibitors, grooms or horses in connection with or arising from the Trials, or the conduct or management thereof, will be recognized.
9. Stabling available for Friday-Sunday at Springdale Racecourse \$25/night, shavings \$6/bag, self-care. Please pre-order shavings.
10. Schooling Fee: \$20/horse, non-refundable, pay gate attendant and pre-enter for show.
11. Due to the pandemic, there will be NO concessions available for this event. It's BYO.
12. Exhibitor Hilltop Parking Fee: \$20/vehicle. Patrons Circle members park at no charge.
