
BOYKIN SPRING FLING

at Cantev Lane Farm in the Boykin Community

Two highly significant properties - historic Pine Grove Plantation and newly-constructed English estate Tishaminga - are new to the event and will be accessible to all riders on the day of the ride. The course will include optional hunter-style fences at Cantey Lane Farm.

SCHEDULE

9:00 a.m. - Noon

TIMED TRAIL RIDE

Riders will compete for the "ideal time" that simulates best the pace of cub hunting. Under these circumstances, it is not about speed but consistency af the fastest time is not necessarily the winning time. There is a lot of open country to move out a fit horse. Group are limited to three riders and will leave every three minutes

(Un-timed) AFTERNOON TRAIL RIDE
Riders will set their own pace over uncomplicated terrain on the same clearly marked course.
Each group is limited to five members; groups will leave every three minutes. This might be a
perfect time to bring out those green horses, old steadies, and "softies".

DIRECTIONS

The Boykin Spring Fling takes place at Cantey Lane Farm, 1200 Sumter Highway, Rembert, South Carolina.

From Camden/Columbia: Take Hwy 521 South toward Boykin (exit 98 on 1-20); go approximately three miles south of 1-20 toward Sumter; take the second gravel road on the left after Tombfield Road.

From Sumter: Take Sumter Highway (Hwy 521) North; approximately three miles beyond Swift Creek Road, Cantey Lane Farm will be on the right. (If you come to Tombfield Road, you've just missed it: turn around and take the econd gravel road to the left.)
