

## General Conditions & Information

1. The Camden Hunt Hunter Trials, The Camden Hunt, or event Committee members shall not be responsible for any accident or damage that may occur to any animal, person, or property. Exhibitors and spectators shall hold the Committee harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident. No claim for damages that may happen to onlookers, exhibitors, grooms or horses in connection with or arising from the Trials, or the conduct or management thereof, will be recognized.
2. Proof of current 12-month negative Coggins required.
3. All vans and trailers are to park at the base of Hunter Trial Hill or entrance of Springdale Race Course.
4. Entries may be emailed to: [hunt@camdenhunt.com](mailto:hunt@camdenhunt.com), submitted on schooling day or on the day of the Trials.
5. The committee has the right to combine, cancel or split any class.
6. Hunt subscribers or members are requested to ride in their colors. Jackets required. Braiding is appreciated.
7. Two entries will go in tandem except Classes 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14
8. Disputes will be decided by the judges, governed by hunting field experience and conditions, and by show ring procedure and etiquette where applicable and not conflicting with these conditions.
9. Please note there is **NO water** available on grounds.
10. Exhibitor Hilltop Parking Fee: \$25/vehicle.
11. Sponsorships available. Gold -\$100. Silver -\$50. Bronze -\$25.

All Class Fees are \$25 except Class 17; there is **no entry fee for Class 17.**

**CLASS 1 JUNIOR FIELD HUNTERS**

To be ridden by a Junior 18 years of age and under for the Elizabeth A Belser Memorial Trophy. Emphasis placed on suitability as a junior field hunter. Fences 2'6".

**CLASS 2 AMATEUR-OWNER HUNTERS**

To be ridden by an Amateur Owner over 18 years for the Richard W. Lloyd Memorial Trophy. Emphasis placed on suitability as amateur field hunter. Fences 2'6".

**CLASS 3 GREEN HUNTERS**

Open to all first-year field hunters that have not previously shown at these trials or at a recognized horse show. Winner receives the Paulette W. Boykin Memorial Trophy. Fences 2'6" ..

**CLASS 4 LOW OPEN HUNTERS**

Open to all entries. Horses Not Eligible for Class 5. Winner receives the Bess & Bob Coughlin Trophy, Fences 2'6".

**CLASS 5 OPEN HUNTERS**

Open to all entries. Horses Not Eligible for Class 4. Winner receives the David L. Young Memorial Trophy. Fences 3'.

**CLASS 6 JUNIOR HUNTER**

Qualified hunters to follow Field Master at a walk, trot, canter/gallop, jumping, reverse of field and/or hold hard. Fences 2'6". Judged on suitability as a first flight hunter. Horse/rider combination NOT eligible for classes 7,8,9,10,11

**CLASS 7 ADULT HUNTER**

Qualified hunters to follow Field Master at a walk, trot, canter/gallop, jumping, reverse of field and/or hold hard. Fences 2'6". Judged on suitability as an adult first flight hunter. Horse/rider combination NOT eligible for classes 7,8,9,10,11

**CLASS 8 JUNIOR HILLTOPPER HUNTER**

Qualified hunters to follow a Field Master at a walk, trot, canter, reverse of field, and/or walking over a log and/or opening a gate. Horse/rider combinations not eligible for any other class except 10 & 11. Judged on suitability as a junior hilltopper mount. Martingales allowed.

**CLASS 9 ADULT HILLTOPPER HUNTER**

Qualified hunters to follow a Field Master at a walk, trot, canter, reverse field and/or walking over a log and/or opening a gate. Horse/rider combinations not eligible for any other classes except 10 & 11. Martingales allowed.

**CLASS 10 HUNTER HACK**

To be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop. May be asked to trot two fences not to exceed 18". Judged on manners, way of going and suitability as a fox hunting mount. Martingales allowed.

**- LUNCH BREAK -**

**CLASS 11 HILLTOPPER HUNTER O/F**

Ridden over a hilltopper course over fences not to exceed 18". Emphasis on suitability as a hilltopper hunter. Entries not eligible for any other class except 7, 8, 9 & 11.

**CLASS 12 HUNT PAIRS UNDER SADDLE**

Open to all entries. To be ridden two abreast at a walk, trot and canter. Judged on pace, performance and general appearance. Martingales allowed.

**CLASS 13 HUNT PAIRS**

Open to all entries. Ridden two abreast over a designated course for the Howard H. Lamar Jr. Memorial Trophy. Judged on performance, pace and general appearance May jump high or low fences.

**CLASS 14 HUNT TEAMS**

Open to all entries for the Martha T. Partridge Perpetual Trophy. Judged on Performance, consistency of spacing, pace and general appearance. May jump high or low fences.

**CLASS 15 HANDY HUNTERS**

Open to all entries with emphasis on manners and promptness. Winner receives the Hilda A. McMahan Trophy. Fences 3'.

**CLASS 16 QUALIFIED HUNTERS**

Open to qualified hunters for the Harry D. Kirkover Perpetual Trophy. Fences 3'.

**CLASS 17 FIELD HUNTER CHALLENGE**

Ridden over a course over fences not to exceed 3'6" with emphasis on brilliance and style. Winner receives the Robert E. Kiehl Memorial Trophy.

**CLASS 18 BEST HUNTER AND BEST TURNED OUT**

Open to all entries that have shown in at least one class. To be ridden by a subscriber (Junior or Senior) of any hunt. To follow Field Master and judged as most suitable to ride to hounds. 2<sup>nd</sup> flight to follow. The Martha H. Williams Perpetual Trophy will be presented to the winner. **NO ENTRY FEE.**
